## SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR MOWING GRASS

These special conditions apply to mowing operations. Permit applicants shall comply with Section 15b of P.A. 51 of 1951; which mandates vegetation mowing and control of brush within the Right of Way of all public roads, except those within the limits of a city or village and designated Federal-aid urban boundaries.

- 1. The minimum mowing height shall not be less than 3 inches above the ground
- 2. Mowing is only permitted between the ditch bottom and Right-of-Way border

## Limited Access Right-of-Way mowing shall comply with the following guidelines:

- 1. The minimum mowing height shall not be less than 3 inches above the ground
- 2. Mowing areas:
  - a. Mowing is only allowed between the ditch bottom and the Right-of-Way fence
  - b. Mowing area limits are established by the MDOT Region Resource Specialist; and are typically started and terminated at natural or physical barriers like; ditches, streams, wooded areas, overpasses, cross roads, and property lines, etc.
- 3. Mowing in the following areas is prohibited:
  - a. Where the ditch is part of a recognized wetland, waterway, or county drain
  - b. In the median area
  - c. On slopes steeper than 1-on-4
- 4. Woody Plants:
  - a. Mowing woody plants is prohibited
  - b. Use of trimmers (line or blade) within 2 feet of a woody plant is prohibited
  - c. Any damaged woody plants shall be replaced by the permittee, at their expense
  - d. Cutting or removing existing woody vegetation is prohibited
- 5. Access options include from:
  - a. The nearest highway shoulder, that is immediately adjacent to the mowing area
  - b. An interchange cross road, a minimum of 300 feet away from a ramp exit or entrance terminal, that is immediately adjacent to the mowing area
  - c. The use of a gate is prohibited
- 6. Mowing times are restricted to weekdays from: 6 pm 8 pm, and weekends from: 8 am to noon
- 7. Litter shall be removed prior to, and after mowing, and shall be properly disposed of by the permittee, at their expense
- 8. Protective apparel shall be worn including: safety vests, hard hats, and eye and ear protection
- 9. Lane or shoulder closures for moving operations are prohibited
- 10. Requests for renewing an annual mowing permit can be submitted annually
