ADOPT-A-LANDSCAPE INSTRUCTIONS FOR MASTER GARDNER CLUBS

These conditions apply when a Master Gardner's Club obtains an Adopt-a-Landscape permit for landscaping in the following two locations:

1. Planting beds within an MDOT's rest area

- All planting areas shall be selected and jointly agreed to by the MDOT TSC Maintenance Coordinator, Region Resource Specialist, and the Master Gardner Representative.
- Irrigation shall be provided by MDOT prior to any purchase of any planting material.
- The size of the landscaping area shall <u>not</u> exceed the Master Gardner's ability to maintain the area.
- Work areas shall be located close to the rest area building or in a safe location selected by MDOT away from vehicular traffic.
- No work shall be located near the Right-of-Way fence.
- No heavy equipment shall be used during the landscaping operation.

Required documentation:

- An Individual Application & Permit-Use of State Trunkline ROW, (Form 2205)
- A requested plant list to ensure plant materials are available locally
- Site Plan Checklist, (Form 3737)*
- Maintenance Plan Checklist, (Form 3740)*

*Note: these documents are needed whenever the landscaping area is large or is located in several plant beds.

2. <u>Landscaping outside of an MDOT's rest area</u>

The following additional documentation shall be submitted when a Master Gardner's Club obtains an Adopt-a-Landscape permit for the landscaping of planting beds *outside* of MDOT's rest area.

- Adopt-a-Landscape Safety Requirements, (Form 3734)
- Letter of Support- from MDOT TSC office
- Context Sensitive Solutions Checklist, (Form 3739)
