Special Conditions for Earthwork Grading Activities

- 1. The permit applicant shall provide the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) with a set of plans identifying the layout and proposed grading area.
- 2. Proposed grade elevation changes shall require the permit applicant to provide cross section drawings for every 25 feet of the roadway.
- 3. The permit applicant shall provide a soil removal & disposal plan and/or soil embankment plan, if applicable.
- 4. Normal access to non-motorized paths, utility facilities, and roadways shall be maintained.
- 5. Drainage shall meet state laws and local ordinances and shall not adversely impact MDOT Right-of-way.
- 6. Access to the grading area and turf establishment site shall be from the adjacent property. Exceptions to this require specific approval from MDOT.
- 7. Embankment material, construction methods, and re-establishment of turf and Right-of-Way fence shall be in accordance with MDOT Standard Plans and Standard Specifications for Construction.
- 8. Soil erosion and sedimentation control (SESC) measures shall be provided prior to grading operations.
- 9. Berm construction and Retention basin or detention basin construction shall not be permitted in the Right-of-way.
