Submit this information using <u>Form 0178</u> via e-mail to <u>MDOT-DBESheets@michigan.gov</u>.

If any Bidder, regardless of bid status (as checked, if available, or as submitted, if TBA), is unable to meet the DBE participation goal, an Abbreviated Contractor Good Faith Effort Application must be provided within 5 calendar days of the bid letting. Submit this information using Form 0188A via e-mail to MDOT-GFE@michigan.gov. This submittal must include the DBE Participation Sheets that will be used to meet any portion of the DBE goal.

A Bidder who fails to meet the submittal requirements within the specified timeframe may be deemed ineligible for award of the contract.

This new requirement is included in <u>12SP-102E-05</u> which will be inserted in all proposals with Federal Aid beginning with the July 12 October 4, 2019, Bid Letting.
