

Industry Forum: Pump Station Permanent Standby Generators – Phase 1 (DB)

9:00 a.m. Apr. 14, 2022

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is hosting an industry forum to discuss the upcoming one-step, low bid design-build (DB) procurement of design and installation of up to 17 permanent standby generators within the Metro Region. This forum will provide an opportunity for potential bidders to learn about the project scope, procurement process and schedule.

The intent of this forum is to share base information of the project for all interested participants and is also meant to be a platform for interactions between contractors and subcontractors. Industry networking and one-on-one meetings scheduled upon request by interested prime contractors will follow the forum.

Project improvements will include design and installation of up to 17 permanent standby generators and associated ancillary infrastructure to improve reliability at select pump stations within the Metro Region. Transfer of power to generator will be automatic when utility power is lost. These stations have been chosen based on high frequency of documented power outages at the station, location in an area that frequently floods, and/or location of pump station makes it difficult or impossible to access with a portable generator.

MDOT anticipates issuance of a Request for Proposals in Spring 2022 and award of a DB contract in Spring/Summer 2022.
