

Industry Forum: Great Lakes Central Railroad over the Muskegon River CMGC Project

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is hosting an industry forum to discuss the upcoming CMGC procurement of Great Lakes Central Railroad (GLC) over the Muskegon River, southwest of the intersection of M-61 and N. Cooks Avenue on the GLC line east of Huckle Berry Trail and west of Thornapple Trail, in the Village of Temple, Redding Township, Clare County. This forum will provide an opportunity for potential bidders to learn about the project scope, procurement process, and schedule.

The intent of this forum is to share base information of the project for all interested participants and is also meant to be a platform for interactions between contractors and subcontractors. Industry networking will follow the forum, along with the opportunity for one-on-one meetings upon request by interested prime contractors.

Project improvements will include the removal and replacement of railroad bridge B02-18201.10.

MDOT anticipates issuance of a Request for Qualifications in June 2024 and award of a CMGC contract in September 2024.
