

## Industry Forum: Southwest Region – M-63 and I-94 BL in the City of St. Joseph CMGC Project

9:30am, May 22, 2024

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is hosting an industry forum to discuss the upcoming Construction Manager / General Contractor (CMGC) procurement for the reconstruction and rehabilitation of the M-63 and I-94 Business Loop in the City of St. Joseph, Berrien County. This forum will provide an opportunity for potential bidders to learn about the project scope, procurement process and schedule.

The intent of this forum is to share base information of the project for all interested participants and is also meant to be a platform for interactions between contractors and subcontractors. Industry networking will follow the forum, along with the opportunity for one-on-one meetings upon request by interested prime contractors.

Project improvements will include pavement reconstruction of M-63 and I-94 BL (including Port and Ship Streets) from Central Avenue to the Blossomland Bridge and Morrison Channel Bridge, pavement rehabilitation of I-94 BL between the Morrison Channel Bridge and the Bicentennial bridge, replacement of all municipal utilities, drainage improvements (complete storm sewer replacement, storm water outfalls and possible stormwater detention and retention), traffic and safety improvements (intersection improvements, signing, pavement marking, traffic signals, and roadway lighting), and streetscaping improvements (sidewalk replacements and ramp upgrades, non-motorized upgrades, landscape plantings, benches and flower pots/bed, etc.).

MDOT anticipates issuance of a Request for Qualifications in June 2024 and award of a CMGC contract in September 2024.
