



**Industry Forum:  
US-23 Improvement Project  
CMGC Project**

**Monday, January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025, 10:00 a.m. EST**

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is hosting an industry forum to discuss the upcoming Construction Manager / General Contractor (CMGC) procurement for the reconstruction of US-23 from I-94 to Earhart Road in the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County. This forum will provide an opportunity for potential bidders to learn about the project scope, procurement process and schedule.

The intent of this forum is to share base information of the project for all interested participants and is also meant to be a platform for interactions between contractors and subcontractors. Industry networking will follow the forum, along with the opportunity for one-on-one meetings upon request by interested prime contractors.

The project scope will be finalized through the Environmental Assessment process which is anticipated to conclude in the spring of 2025. The US-23 Improvement Project is anticipated to include reconstruction of US-23 from I-94 to south of Geddes Road, structure work including preventive maintenance repairs and bridge replacements, improvements to accommodate future transit plans, reconstruction and ramp widening from westbound I-94 to northbound US-23, reconstruction and reconfiguration of the US-23/M-17 interchange, including reconstruction of Washtenaw Avenue, culvert replacements, noise barrier and possible retaining walls, multimodal improvements, and safety improvements.

MDOT anticipates issuance of a Request for Qualifications in January 2025 and award of a CMGC preconstruction contract in April 2025.
