





Specialists review all projects that may cause environmental impact Specialists will reach out to PMs



- Given after all Specialists approved project
- ROW/Design Phase
- Mitigation measures listed in document
  - Noted in plans/proposal
  - Special Provisions
  - Permits
  - Restricted Work Areas



### Right-of-Way Acquisition



- Once Environmental Classification occurs, Real Estate may proceed with purchasing property.
- The Classification document will contain a list of properties that can **not** be purchased for environmental reasons

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#### **Environmental Certification**

- Construction Phase
- Occurs prior to OEC meeting
- All mitigation items are included in the plans
- All areas of concern are avoided
