Kim is a project manager in the Traffic Signing. She also supports the Traffic Control Order program and the maintenance of standards and guidelines.

Kwame practices his craft of sign making in the Statewide Sign Shop for MDOT. He is responsible for the unique signs you may see along state trunkline.

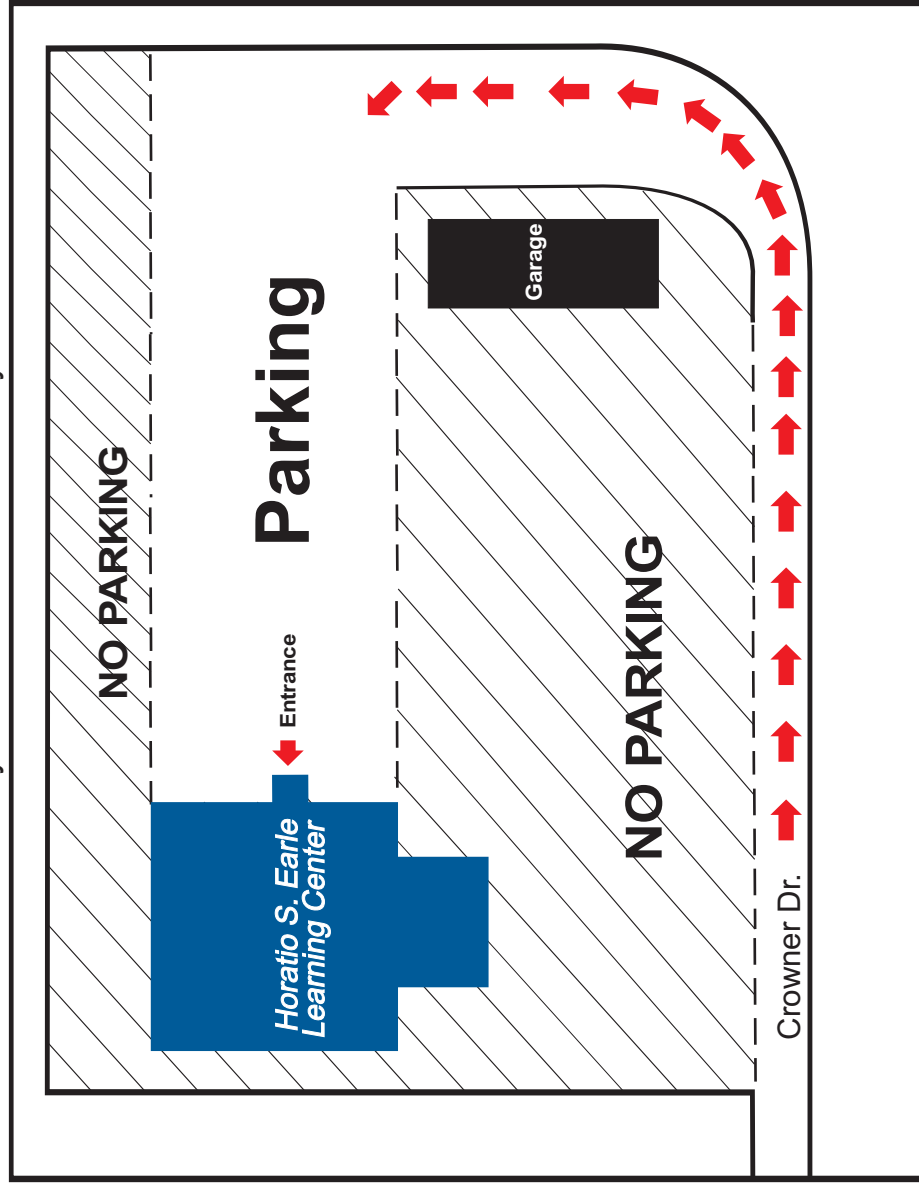
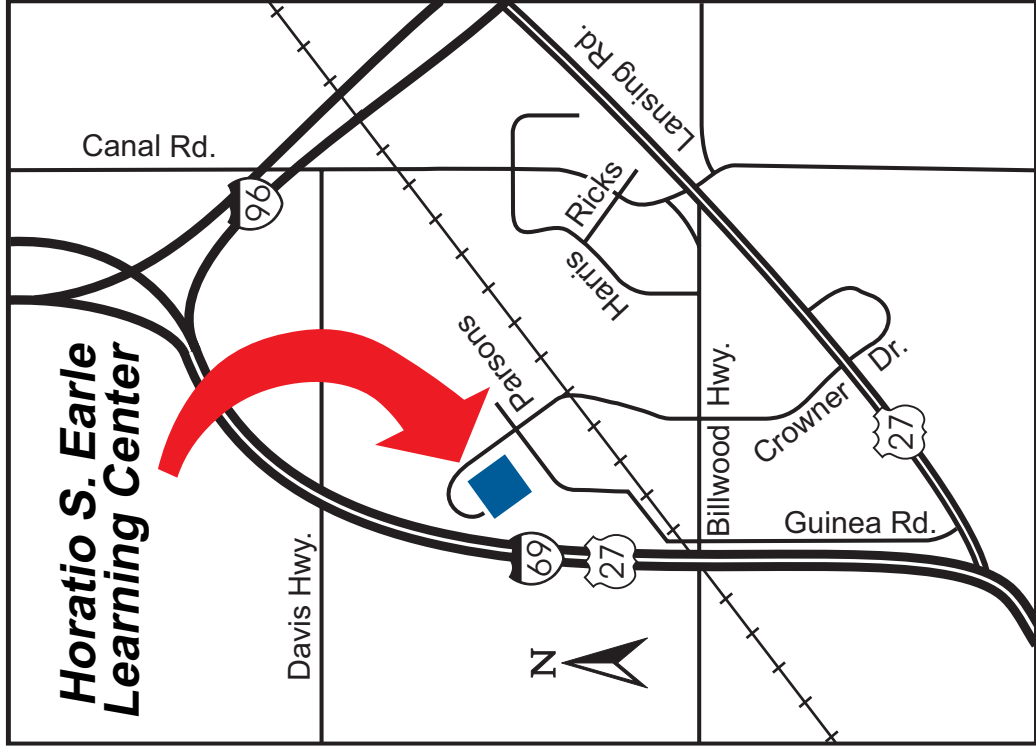

Exit off 98A, if you're coming East or West on I-96. Head south on Lansing Road. Crowner Drive is the second traffic light after the I-96 interchange. Turn right onto Crowner Drive.
