a. Description. This work consists of designing, furnishing, installing, maintaining, and removing temporary Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) signs. Furnish signing for high profile BIL projects in accordance with section 812 of the Standard Specifications for Construction, unless otherwise directed herein or by the Department.

b. Materials. Ensure signing is in accordance with section 919 of the Standard Specifications of Construction. Ensure reflective sheeting is in accordance with subsection 922.02.B of the Standard Specifications for Construction.

c. Construction. Fabrication of BIL signs must conform to the sign layout details shown in Detail 1 of this special provision.

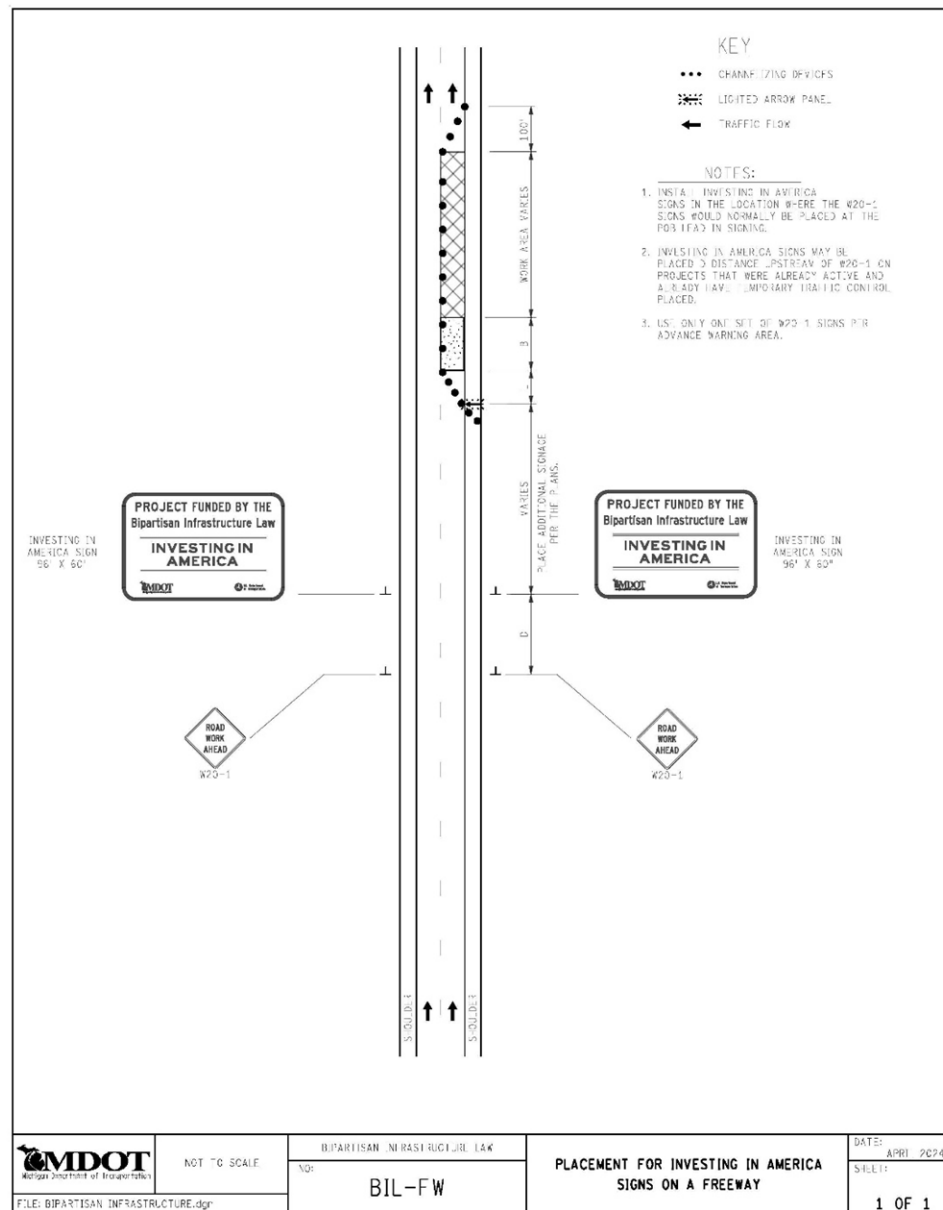


Figure 1: Detail for Placement for Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Signs on Freeways

1. Install BIL signs at locations as shown on Figure 1 of this special provision for work zones on freeways, or as directed by the Engineer.

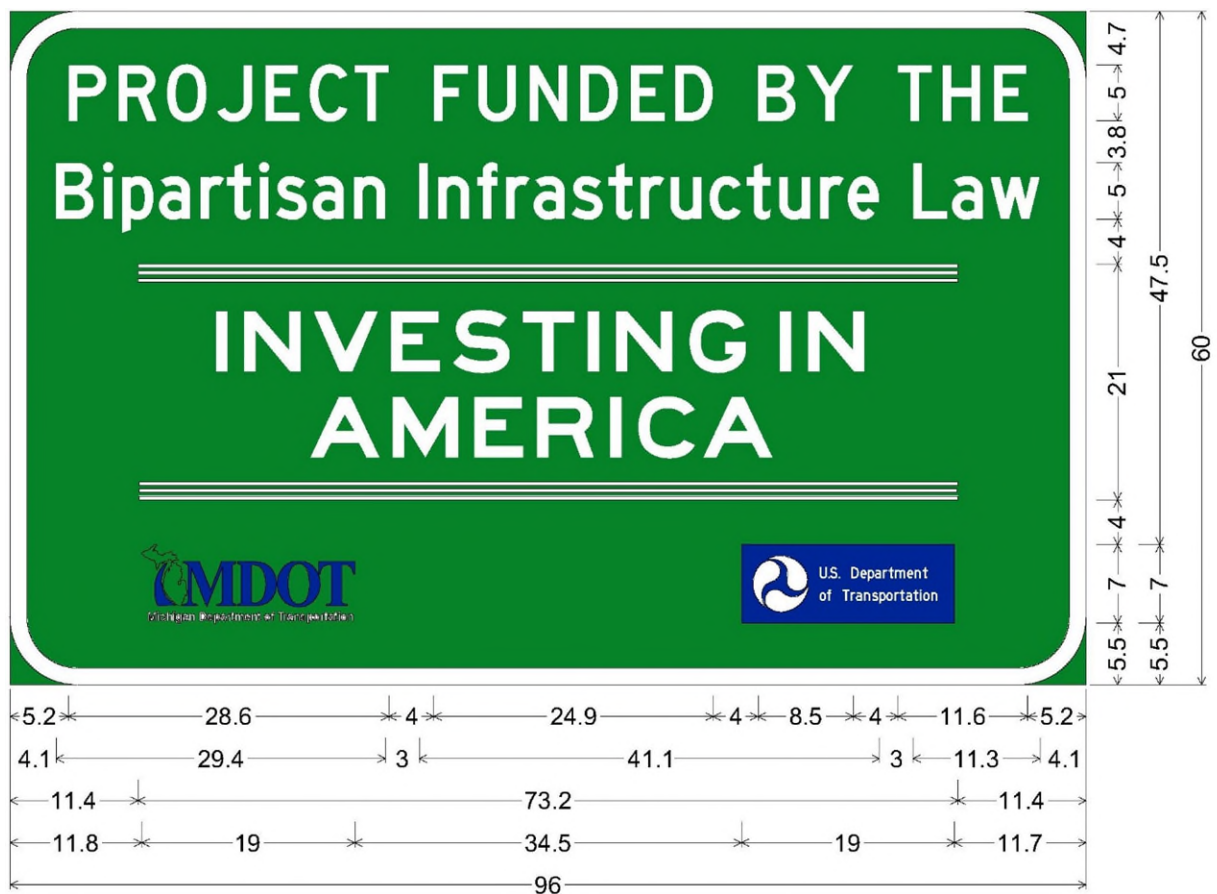
2. Post type will be determined by the Sign Support Selection Chart ([SIGN-150-D.pdf](#)).

d. Measurement and Payment. The completed work, as described, will be measured and paid per the Standard Specifications for Construction using the following pay items:

Pay Item	Pay Unit
Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Sign, Freeway, Type IIA, Temp, Oper.....	Each
Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Sign, Freeway, Type IIA, Temp, Furn	Each

1. **Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Sign, Freeway, Type IIA, Temp, Oper** will be paid for as described in subsection 812.04.D of the Standard Specifications for Construction.

2. **Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Sign, Freeway, Type IIA, Temp, Furn** will be paid for as described in subsection 812.04.C of the Standard Specifications for Construction.
