AN ACT to authorize and empower the state highway commissioner to purchase or condemn property or interests in property to exchange for the property, rights of way, or any part thereof or interests therein, owned by railroads, railways or public utilities, having the right of eminent domain, when such property, rights of way, or any part thereof or interest therein, is necessary to be acquired for establishing, constructing, widening, straightening, altering, relocating or otherwise improving a trunk line highway, and to make such exchange.

AN ACT to codify the laws relating to the laying out of drainage districts, the consolidation of drainage districts, the construction and maintenance of drains, sewers, pumping equipment, bridges, culverts, fords, and the structures and mechanical devices to properly purify the flow of drains; to provide for flood control projects; to provide for water management, water management districts, and subdistricts, and for flood control and drainage projects within drainage districts; to provide for the assessment and collection of taxes; to provide for the investment of funds; to provide for the deposit of funds for future maintenance of drains; to authorize public corporations to impose taxes for the payment of assessments in anticipation of which bonds are issued; to provide for the issuance of bonds by drainage districts and for the pledge of the full faith and credit of counties for payment of the bonds; to authorize counties to impose taxes when necessary to pay principal and interest on bonds for which full faith and credit is pledged; to validate certain acts and bonds; and to prescribe penalties.

TRANSPORTATION ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUND

Act 231 of 1987

AN ACT to create a transportation economic development fund in the state treasury; to prescribe the uses of and distributions from this fund; to create the office of economic development and to prescribe its powers and duties; to prescribe the powers and duties of the state transportation department, state transportation commission, and certain other bodies; and to permit the issuance of certain bonds.

TREES AND SHRUBS

Act 2 of 1921 (1st Ex. Sess.)

AN ACT to provide for the protection and care of certain trees and shrubs within the limits of public highways within the state of Michigan and for the planting of trees and shrubs as a part of the maintenance of the road in certain cases.

TRUNK LINE HIGHWAYS

Act 17 of 1925

1925, Act 17, Eff. Aug. 27, 1925

AN ACT to provide for the construction, improvement and maintenance of trunk line highways.

UNITED STATES FIELD NOTES, MAPS, PLATS, AND RECORDS

Act 55 of 1927

1927, Act 55, Imd. Eff. Apr. 18, 1927

AN ACT to designate the Michigan historical commission as the proper state agency to receive and safely keep the field notes, maps, plats, records and all other papers appertaining to land titles in the public survey office of the United States in said state.

VACATION OR ALTERATION OF STATE HIGHWAY

Act 274 of 1929

1929, Act 274, Eff. Aug. 28, 1929

AN ACT to prohibit counties, townships, cities and villages from vacating and altering state highways and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act.

VALIDATION OF INSTRUMENTS CONVEYING LANDS FOR TRUNK LINE HIGHWAYS

Act 282 of 1929

1929, Act 282, Imd. Eff. May 22, 1929

AN ACT to validate instruments conveying title to the state of certain lands for state trunk line highways and to authorize the sale of such parts of said lands as are not needed for trunk line highways.
