MSP will provide work zone law enforcement activities. Requests will be made one week in advance whenever possible. MSP commits to wearing high visibility apparel and providing law enforcement training, as appropriate, to their officers.

The maximum number of enforcement hours is listed in the form above. The specified hourly rate for this service will be billed at the overtime rate(s) and retirement costs per hour per officer. The compensated mileage rate will be as written in the form above.

MSP agrees to provide MDOT a Summary of Traffic Enforcement Activities with each invoice submittal. The Summary of Traffic Enforcement Activities is requested to include the following information:

- Officer's Name
- Hourly Rate
- Dates Worked
- Enforcement Location
- Total Patrol Hours
