

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR CLOSURE OF A STATE HIGHWAY BY LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY

Any road closure and detours must be affected through compliance with the requirements of Act 200 PA 1969. The following will be required:

1. Permit from the Michigan Department of Transportation.
2. Request by an authorized official designated by resolution of the governing body of a city, incorporated village, or township, which will specify.
 - a. Time and date highway is to be closed to traffic.
 - b. Time and date highway is to be reopened to traffic.
3. The resolution must specify that the permittee shall save harmless the Michigan Department of Transportation and its employees from claims of every kind arising out of the closure of the roadway and out of the permit (Rule 78).
4. The permittee shall provide adequate arrangements to the satisfaction of the Michigan Department of Transportation for the handling of traffic during the closure and shall assume all costs incurred for the maintaining of traffic, including but not limited to signs, barricades, police protection, etc.
5. The lead agency shall secure and submit to the Michigan Department of Transportation resolutions concurring in the detours from all affected jurisdictional bodies, and providing the language in No. 3 above.
6. Compliance with administrative rules promulgated pursuant to Act 200 PA 1969. Rules 81 through 83 (R247.281 -R247.285) will be required.
