

NON-PROFIT REQUIREMENTS FOR SERVING REFRESHMENTS IN REST AREAS ON NON-HOLIDAYS

Public service non-profit organizations may be granted permission by issuance of a permit to use rest areas for serving non-alcoholic refreshments to the traveling public with proof of their non-profit status.
