Instructions for Mobility Policy Requirements

- 1. Review Mobility Impact Map and determine if work is in restricted or prohibit State highway Right-of-Way.
- 2. <u>If the work is not located in a restricted or prohibited State highway Right-of-Way but will take more than one daylight period.</u> Complete a mobility analysis.

If the work is located in restricted or prohibited State highway Right-of-Way
Access Route Time Restriction Details and determine if there are work hour
restrictions

- If work hour restrictions exist, determine if the work can be completed outside of the restrictions. The TSC Construction Permit Staff may assist in determining if this if necessary.
- 4. If work cannot be completed outside of the restrictions a mobility analysis shall be completed. See the MDOT Mobility Policy. A consultant may be needed to complete the mobility analysis.
- 5. If the mobility analysis shows a significant impact to travel time delay, volume to capacity ratio or level of service, a Transportation Management Plan shall be completed and submitted with the permit application.

Note: All work requires the submission of a Construction permit application package or 5-day Advance Notice, (Form 2205) and approval from the TSC before work is to be performed in State highway Right-of-Way.
