

Special Conditions for Earthwork Grading Activities

1. The permit applicant shall provide the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) with a set of plans identifying the layout and proposed grading area.
2. Proposed grade elevation changes shall require the permit applicant to provide cross section drawings for every 25 feet of the roadway.
3. The permit applicant shall provide a soil removal & disposal plan and/or soil embankment plan, if applicable.
4. Normal access to non-motorized paths, utility facilities, and roadways shall be maintained.
5. Drainage shall meet state laws and local ordinances and shall not adversely impact MDOT Right-of-way.
6. Access to the grading area and turf establishment site shall be from the adjacent property. Exceptions to this require specific approval from MDOT.
7. Embankment material, construction methods, and re-establishment of turf and Right-of-Way fence shall be in accordance with MDOT Standard Plans and Standard Specifications for Construction.
8. Soil erosion and sedimentation control (SESC) measures shall be provided prior to grading operations.
9. Berm construction and Retention basin or detention basin construction shall not be permitted in the Right-of-way.
